

In 1965, manufacturing accounted for more than 30 percent of state gross domestic product in sixteen states, with the highest percentage found in Michigan, at 48.6 percent. Nearly three quarters of the states (36) reported that manufacturing production accounted for at least 15 percent of their overall production in 1965. In contrast, by 2005 no state had its manufacturing output account for at least 30 percent of the total state gross domestic product. That year, Indiana reported the highest share of manufacturing production at 26.9 percent and nearly three quarters of the states (36) reported that manufacturing production accounted for less than 15 percent of their overall state production.
