Dallas Exports in 2015

- Goods exports from the Dallas area have increased \$7.5 billion since 2009.
- On average, exports from the Dallas area have increased by 2.9% annually over the past 10 years.




Exports Sustain Dallas Area Businesses

- In 2014 (latest available), 5,407 Dallas area companies exported to U.S. FTA partners.
- The same year, 5,019 area companies exported to Trans-Pacific Partnership countries and 2,402 exported to the European Union.

Top Dallas Export Markets & Sectors


- In 2015, Mexico was Dallas's top foreign market, accounting for 17% of its total goods exports.
- Computer & electronic products was Dallas's top export sector in 2015, accounting for 25% of the area's goods exports.



In addition to these top markets, Dallas is also a major exporter to:

- Netherlands \$1.1 billion
- United Kingdom \$1.1 billion
- Singapore \$970 million
- Hong Kong \$891 million
- Belgium \$771 million

- Agricultural products



Current and Future FTAs Matter to Dallas Area Exporters

- The U.S. currently has 14 free trade agreements in force with 20 countries.

In 2015, exports to FTA markets accounted for **45%** of Dallas area exports


