Detroit Exports in 2015

- Goods exports from the Detroit area have increased \$15.9 billion since 2009.
- On average, exports from the Detroit area have increased by 0.9% annually over the past 10 years.




Exports Sustain Detroit Area Businesses

- In 2014 (latest available), 5,204 Detroit area companies exported to U.S. FTA partners.
- The same year, 5,088 area companies exported to Trans-Pacific Partnership countries and 1,987 exported to the European Union.


Top Detroit Export Markets & Sectors

- In 2015, Mexico was Detroit's top foreign market, accounting for 39% of its total goods exports.
- Transportation equipment was Detroit's top export sector in 2015, accounting for 57% of the area's goods exports.



In addition to these top markets, Detroit is also a major exporter to:

Italy \$913 million
Australia \$714 million
United Arab Emirates \$634 million
Thailand \$256 million
Spain \$223 million



In addition to these top sectors, other sectors where Detroit is a major exporter include:

- Plastics & rubber products
- Primary metal manufactures
- Chemicals
- Textiles & fabrics
- Miscellaneous manufactures


Current and Future FTAs Matter to Detroit Area Exporters

- The U.S. currently has 14 free trade agreements in force with 20 countries.

In 2015, exports to FTA markets accounted for **77%** of Detroit area exports


