- On March 8, the General Administration of Quality Supervision, Inspection and Quarantine (AQSIQ) published a list of 31 foreign scrap suppliers, whose registration qualification will be suspended. The listed companies may submit their appeals or rectification reports to AQSIQ within 60 days of this announcement. The registration qualification will be revoked if companies fail to submit the required document within the 60-day window.
